Some Important Exam Rules:

1. Students should arrive at the college at least 15 minutes before the start of the scheduled examination.
2. Bring a valid form of identification, such as a student ID card and admit card.
3. Bring only the materials allowed for the exam, such as pens, pencils, erasers, rulers, and any permitted reference materials or calculators
4. Using mobile phones and smart watches during exam time is strictly prohibited.

If anyone is found using such devices

- i. A fine of Rs.500 will be charged
 - ii. The confiscated device will be returned only after at least a day
5. Sit at the designated seat assigned by the invigilator.
 6. Raise your hand if you need clarification on any question or instruction.
 7. Permitted to use the washroom after one hour from the start of the exam so raise your hand to get the attention of an invigilator.
 8. Students taking terminal exams are not permitted to leave the class until an hour has elapsed from the start of the exam.
 9. If any student is unable to attend the examinations due to personal reasons, they must inform in advance by sending an email to admin.nist@nacol.edu.np & exam@nacolnlist.edu.np. Notifications through calls, SMS, or WhatsApp will not be accepted.
 10. If a student is absent or fails the examination, they must pay a fine of Rs. 300 to take a re-examination. If a student is unable to pass the re-examination, it could potentially lead to further consequences.
