Some Important Exam Rules:

1. Students should arrive at the college at least **15** minutes before the start of the scheduled examination.
2. Bring a valid form of identification, such as a student ID card and admit card.
3. Bring only the materials allowed for the exam, such as pens, pencils, erasers, rulers, and any permitted reference materials or calculators
4. Using mobile phones and smart watches during exam time is strictly prohibited.

If anyone is found using such devices

- i. A fine of **Rs.500** will be charged
 - ii. The confiscated device will be returned only after at least a day
5. Sit at the designated seat assigned by the invigilator.
6. Raise your hand if you need clarification on any question or instruction.
7. Permitted to use the washroom after one hour from the start of the exam so raise your hand to get the attention of an invigilator.
8. Students taking terminal exams are not permitted to leave the class until an hour has elapsed from the start of the exam.
9. If any student is unable to attend the examinations due to personal reasons, they must inform in advance by sending an email to admin.nist@nacol.edu.np & exam@nacolnist.edu.np. Notifications through calls, SMS, or WhatsApp will not be accepted.
10. Students who are absent or fail the examination must take a re-examination. The re-examination fee is **Rs. 500** for absent students and **Rs. 300** for failed students. Failure to pass the re-examination may result in further academic action.
